Novelties

LUGANO

With LUGANO, KETTLER presents a newly conceived, stackable aluminium chair with a casual design. The seat is made of textile with integrated upholstery, naturally quick-drying and finished with Olefin threads for an exclusive look. Thanks to its special design, the seat appears to float, making it a visual highlight and reminiscent of Art Deco with its different levels.



SENSE

This is a new chair segment that focuses on colour and materiality and is available as a high back in the Black Line and as a low and high back in the White Line.

The special feature is the bronze-coloured textile upholstery with teak inlays in the armrests and the use of recycled material, e.g. PET bottles, which have been reused here and are now being given a second chance as a high-quality KETTLER chair.

SLIGHT

Time to relax: Camping is nostalgically beautiful and very much in vogue. The sector has been growing continuously for many years and is becoming increasingly important. KETTLER successfully offered camping chairs back in the early 1960s. The latest additions are a multi-position chair and a stool, which can be stowed away as quickly as they can be unpacked and put in the right position.

WHITE LINE

KETTLER successfully launched the White Line at spoga+gafa 2024. This previously included the DIAMOND segment, which was very well received by customers in the light shades. For the 2026 season, further models will be reinterpreted and equipped with different, elegant shades of beige. These include the PARADISO Hollywood swing, which can be used as a 3-seater or folded out as a lounge for two people.

MEMPHIS is also a new addition to the White Line and is available as a multi-position armchair, stackable armchair with teak applications on the backrest and armrests and as a stool. This is not only visually extremely elegant, but also super-light, weather-resistant and the decorative applications are of course made of certified teak. There is also a matching new teak table top with a wing profile for an even higher-quality look.

KETTLER by LEON and KETTLER by FINN

The result is a modular system made of bouclé, a timeless, almost simple-looking material with an unrivalled elegance that is considered an eternal classic in fashion. Bouclé has been used in the furniture industry for some time now, but brings a new and fresh look to the outdoor area. The material is hard-wearing, hardly creases and is easy to work with.

Tables and sun protection

The table range remains as large as ever due to its immense popularity: whether classic dining table, multifunctional extendable table, side table or various forms of folding tables, KETTLER has the right table for every outdoor occasion. New are the CUBIC-X-Leg table frames in 95x95 and 160x95 cm as well as a supplementary format of 180x100 cm and new decors in the table top range.

The topic of sun protection is just as relevant and is considered very generously in terms of function, appearance and colour selection. New sizes, fabric qualities and colours are being added to the range.

Textiles and accessories

KETTLER Home&Garden is presenting an expanded textile concept for 2026 to make outdoor living even more beautiful, cosy and sustainable.

The cushions and cushion covers are made from materials that have been fished out of the water as waste. Functionality always plays a major role at KETTLER Home&Garden: the covers of the new, sustainably produced cushions are all washable and have zips to ensure easy cover changes.

With the MICRO-KETTLIGHTS, another highlight has been added to the well-established lighting collection. 20 cm of style and function in the colours cream, taupe, sand, grey blue and rust make them an eye-catcher on the balcony or patio.
